

Entry for Holders of Approved Immigration Permits or Approved Applications

(For applicants who have received an approval letter for an Immigration Permit issued by the Civil Registry and Migration Department of the Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Cyprus.)

Document Checklist:

1.	Original visa application form, completed in full and signed by the applicant personally (or by the legal guardian of a minor).	Original
2.	One recent passport-sized photograph (3.5x4.5 cm) of the applicant attached to the form. The photo must show the applicant facing forward directly, with a white background. Original passport: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Validity must exceed the validity of the requested visa by at least three months.• Copies of the passport's first page, last page, and all pages containing used visas and entry/exit stamps.	Original
3.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If the applicant holds an old passport, the original old passport must be submitted along with copies of its first page, last page, and all pages with used visas and stamps. Original Immigration Permit of type A, B, C, D, E, F or under regulation 6(2) issued by the Civil Registry and Migration Department of Cyprus, OR original/copy of the official letter from the Civil Registry and Migration Department confirming the applicant has applied for and been approved for an Immigration Permit. <i>If the applicant can only provide the spouse's/parent's Immigration Permit, the following additional documents are required:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• For Spouse: Original and copy of Marriage Certificate, OR original notarized and translated Marriage Certificate with dual authentication by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of Cyprus. A copy is sufficient if the marriage certificate was issued in Cyprus.• For Child: Original notarized and translated Certificate of Kinship with parents, with dual authentication by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of Cyprus.	Original & Copy
4.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• For Spouse: Original and copy of Marriage Certificate, OR original notarized and translated Marriage Certificate with dual authentication by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of Cyprus. A copy is sufficient if the marriage certificate was issued in Cyprus.• For Child: Original notarized and translated Certificate of Kinship with parents, with dual authentication by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of Cyprus. 5.	Copy of flight reservation and/or itinerary (round-trip ticket reservation showing exact entry and exit dates between China and Cyprus). Do not purchase tickets	Copy

6.	Original Household Registration Book (Hukouben) for Chinese citizens, with copies and English translations of all informative pages. If current residence differs from Hukou location, provide the original, copy, and English translation of a Residence Certificate.	Original, Copy & Translation

For Minors (under 18 years old):

The following documents (Birth Certificate, Parental Consent Authentication) require English translation and dual authentication by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of Cyprus in China. (If the minor's parents are not in China, the consent must be notarized and authenticated by the competent authorities in their country of residence.)

7.	If the minor travels alone or with one parent: Notarized Parental Consent Letter from both parents/legal guardians (for traveling alone) OR from the non-traveling parent/legal guardian (for traveling with one parent). The consent must clearly state the country of visit, purpose, and duration of travel.	Original
8.	Original Birth Certificate of the minor and Apostille (Hague Authentication).	Original
